## **SUMMER WORKSHOP 2010**

Summer Workshop is an annual week-long event that allows individuals an opportunity to learn from one of two invited instructors. It is an intensive, educational and creative experience spent with other fiber enthusiasts. Participation is not limited to Guild members.

This year, we are pleased to offer two very different instructors who are well established in their chosen field. Dorothy Caldwell, from Hastings ON, will present her “A Book of Marks” workshop. In this workshop, participants will examine different aspects of mark making. Drawn and painted marks, stitched marks, unconventional marks such as burning, stenciling and piercing, marks on fabric including batik, stenciling, printing, and rubbings will each address a different aspect of mark making and activating a surface. Simple bookbinding techniques will be demonstrated enabling students to construct a book form incorporating their own imagery and materials together with pages produced throughout the week.

Jane Davila, from Ridgefield, Connecticut is our other instructor. The exact format and topic of this workshop is not determined at this time. Jane is a fibre and mixed media artist.
